








The first session of the day was "The Role of healthy life style in preventing pandemics". The session was handled by **Dr. Hanish Babu** Immediate Past President, Association of Kerala Medical and Dental Graduates, UAE. Dr. Hanish Babu has worked as a Consultant Dermatologist in Kerala for 4 years. At present he is working in Cosmolaser Medical Centre, Sharjah as Cosmetologist and Dermatologist.





**Dr. Hanish Babu** gave us an idea of the various stages of the infection in human body with the severity of illness as time progresses. Dr gave a clear picture of the current situation regarding the COVID-19 in various countries, with the COVID-19 Case surveillance-United States from January to May 2020. Dr also explained the individual health management strategies to reduce risk of SARS-CoV-II infection and to moderate the severity of COVID-19.



It was explained that there are many preventive and protective measures that can be taken against COVID-19. Dr explained the need for a healthy lifestyle. Dr conveyed that Life without health is nothing but a Burden for us and others. Healthy balanced diet, Regular exercise, rest and sleep, relaxed lifestyle, proactive attitude, periodic health check-up and avoiding unhealthy diet are the key ways for a healthy lifestyle. Dr urged us to think positive and to remove negativity from words, deeds and thoughts.


## **♦ INTERACTIVE SESSION WITH FIRST YEAR STUDENTS BY ECE**




## ✤ HOBBY SHARING COMPETITION ORGANIZED BY CSE




#### 3. INTERACTIVE SESSION WITH ALUMNI










#### ✤ An Online Photograpy Competition Conducted By CSE Department





# ✤ World Internet Day










# ✤ INTERNATIONAL DAY FOR THE GIRL CHILD – HOLDING POSTER
