REPORT ON HOSPITAL CLEANING PROGRAMME

21st July 2016

OBJECTIVES :

The program aimed to clean the Kesavapuram Community Health Center and its surroundings there by preventing the fast spreading of diseases and gave awareness for volunteers about diseases during the summer season.

REPORT:

VAST TC NSS Unit conducted an outdoor cleaning programme in accordance with Swachh Bharat Mission on 21st July 2016 at the Kesavapuram Community Health Center. The program aimed at the prevention of fast spreading of diseases during this season.

The program was coordinated by NSS programme officer Mr. Vishnu. P. C and started at 10am. It was supervised by the staff members Mr. Lenin Babu, Smt. Rooby.V, Mr. Deepak, and Smt. Sabna and NSS secretaries Praveen and Deethu Dinesh. The NSS Programme officer Mr. Vishnu. P. C explained the guidelines for cleaning the hospital area. We also ensured that the volunteers had masks and gloves. The program commenced with the NSS song thereafter students were divided into different groups.





The hospital surroundings contained many plastic bottles, hospital wastes and other waste materials. It was cleaned by the volunteers and properly disposed of. Also the weeds and grass were removed and water stagnated areas were cleared. To refresh their activities the hospital authority sponsored snacks and lemonade. **Total of 87 NSS volunteers participated in the program.**

OUTCOME:

Through this programme we were able to provide awareness about the need for cleanliness and thereby preventing fast spreading of diseases and also the hospital surroundings were cleaned by removing plastic materials, weeds and grass.

The students shared the woeful experiences of all the inmates, consoled them and offered them articles to daily use, vegetables, fruits, cookies and the most precious was to give vent to the feelings of the old which made many outburst their emotions. They were very happy to see the gifts. They blessed us, and we promised that we will come again to meet them. We learnt a lesson that day, which was to treat the aged with love and affection. Every person, who puts a parent in a home for the aged, should ask himself how he would feel if his children did the same to him when he became old. **Total of 100 students from NSS UNIT VAST TC participated in this event.**

It was really a joyous experience for all volunteers to visit the old age home and interact with its inmates. The most inspiring thing there was that in spite of facing so many hardships these aged people have brave hearts and are still trying to find endless ways to be happy to live.





OUTCOMES:

The elderly were happy to see the students and spend time with them. Students were excited and enjoyed the programme by actively interacting with the natives. Through this programme students were able to provide companionship, emotional support and happiness to the natives.

REPORT:

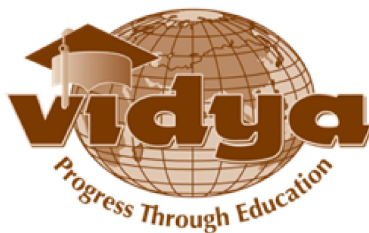

16th November 2016

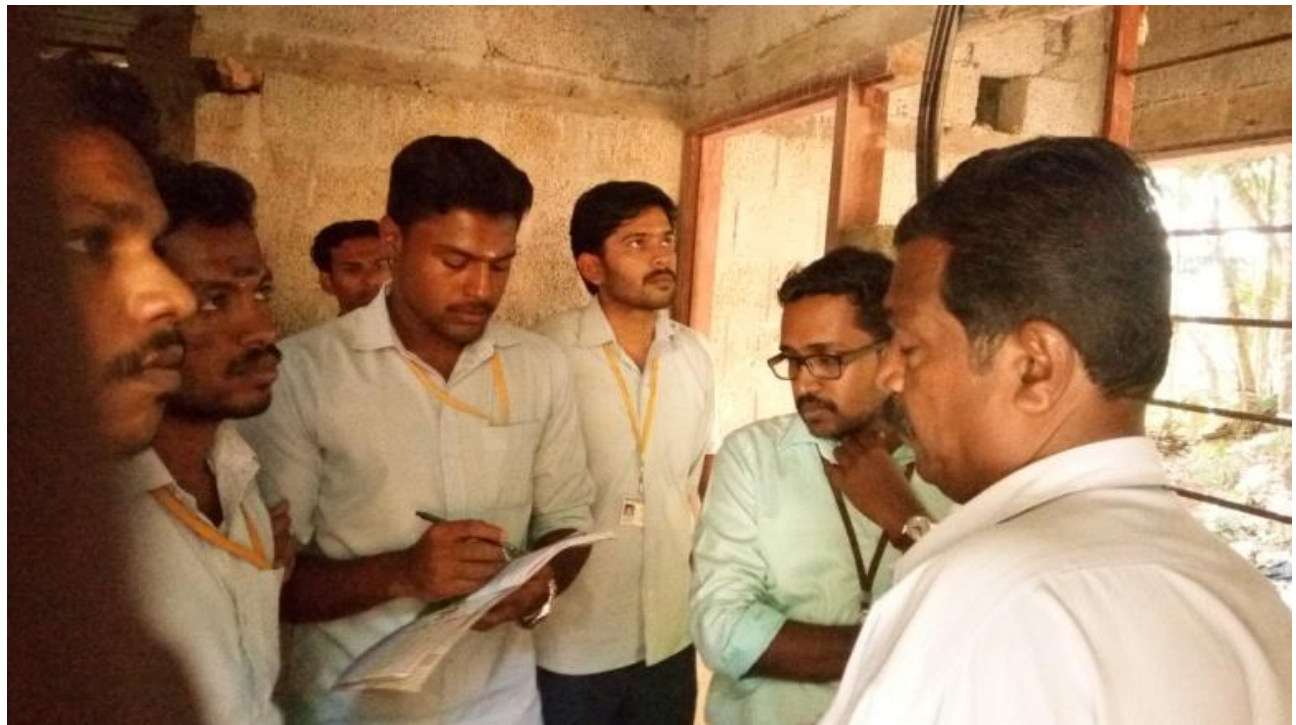
OBJECTIVE:

- To provide electrical assistance to local people near college.
- To help students to get insight to the electrical wiring

REPORT :

The students of S5 EEE, VAST TC, Kilimanoor, were completed wiring of a house as part of the Department association (TESLA) activity. This will help the students to get insight to the electrical wiring. We selected a poor house which is 3 km away from college. A batch of **15 students of S5 EEE** led by the tutor Mr. Vishnu P C, and an electrician visited that house on 16th November 2016 at 1 pm. Our primary aim in the visit is to get the estimation and average cost of electrical components. We arrived there at 1.15 pm and the electrician and sir explained basic concepts, various standards and procedures in electrical wiring. By the help of an electrician we successfully completed the estimation using the layout of the house, computed the cost of required items and connected load rating of equipment etc. That house includes 2 bedrooms, kitchen, bathroom, veranda and hall. Finally we drew the circuit layout individually and discussed it in groups. We reached the college at 2.30 pm after completing the work. The program was coordinated by Dr. John Wiselin (HOD EEE) and Mr. Vishnu P C.





OUTCOME:

Students were able to gain practical knowledge about electrical wiring estimation in houses.



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REPORT ON HARITHA KERALAM

8th December 2016

OBJECTIVE:

To make awareness among the students about the importance of organic farming and waste management.

REPORT:

The state government of Kerala launched Haritha Keralam Mission on 8th December 2016 to create new developments by the optimum utilization of the natural resources. REPORT:
