→ ONE DAY OJT ON INTRODUCTION TO COMPUTER HARDWARE & NETWORKING

The Department of Computer Science & Engineering, VAST TC, in association with CODIAC organized a One Day On - the - job Training (OJT) on "Computer Hardware & Networking" on 2nd March 2022. The resource persons of the programme were Ms. Krishna L (Asst.Prof-CSE), Mr. Suraj S R (System Manager/Asst. Prof. CSE) and Mr. Vinod T F (ITIMS Administrator) Coordinated by Ms. Ansha Shakkeer (Asst. Prof-CSE), Ms. Revathy Prasannan (Asst. Prof-CSE). Total of 41 VHSE students of VVHSS Poredom participated in the OJT, and got very encouraging responses through the feedback forms provided and also from the question and answer sessions. The programme was structured in 4 sessions, followed by Q&A session and the feedback was collected from all participants.

SESSION 1: 9:30 AM TO 11:00 AM

- Hardware familiarization
- The resource person presented a very informative session about fundamental components of the computer system such as hardware software etc.
- Explained the functionalities of input and output devices.
- Various types of software like system software and application software.

SESSION 2: 11:10 AM TO 1:00 PM

- Assembling and OS Installation
- The Resource Person presented a detailed session about assembling of various parts of computer system and took a live session on CC Lab
- Explained the step by step procedure for installation of different Operating Systems like Windows, Linux etc.

SESSION 3: 1:30 PM TO 2:30 PM

- Introduction to computer Networks
- Given a brief introduction about computer Networks and type of Networks such as LAN WAN, MAN, network devices – Router, Bridge, Switches, Hub and Network topologies like Star, Mesh, Tree, Bus.

SESSION 4: 2:30 PM- 4:00 PM

- Crimping and Troubleshooting
- The resource person took a live session on fixing technical issues on computers and software systems.

At the end of the session, the resource person explained the Career opportunities and shared motivating success stories of our students. Also shared information about our college, achievements of our students. Some of the participants asked their doubts in the Q&A session. The event concluded at 4:00 P M. The event was a great success and got a positive response from all the participants.

The session was very much informative. The participants are now able to know about the fundamental components of the computer system, installation of different Operating Systems, Crimping and Troubleshooting. The participants were highly motivated and interested throughout the sessions. In the feedback sessions, participants gave a positive response, citing it to be relevant, being taught at a good pace.

The session was about attending an interview confidently. It also covered the topics like appearance, use of hand gestures and body posture while presenting and also covered the main points that must be included in the self-introduction phase.


