Students and 13 Parents attended the session



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

The session commenced at 11:00 am. The session was highly Motivated and inspirational for the students. The response of the students is overwhelming. Father started his session on how we can differentiate between ordinary and extraordinary people. Students responded with their aspects and father gave points to each branch. He explained how to become an effective and successful person in our life. He explained hard work is the key to success. Father explained that for a successful life we want a perfect goal, determination and hard work. Father shared motivational videos to the students and asked students to explain the facts. Students shared their point of views. Father explained the following points

The motivation stories improved the self confidence among students. The students share their ideas and thoughts throughout the session. The students expressed their viewpoints. 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
