
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
reinforcing session. The training program was well appreciated by the students and they gave good feedback about the trainers as well. The attendance of the students are as follows.



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


CGP program conducted at RV HSS, Valakam, Kottarakkara Area

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✤ ALUMINI TALK FOR FIRST YEAR EEE STUDENTS ORGANIZED BY EEE












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***** PANCHAYAT BUS STAND CLEANING INITIATIVE BY NSS


