REPORT:

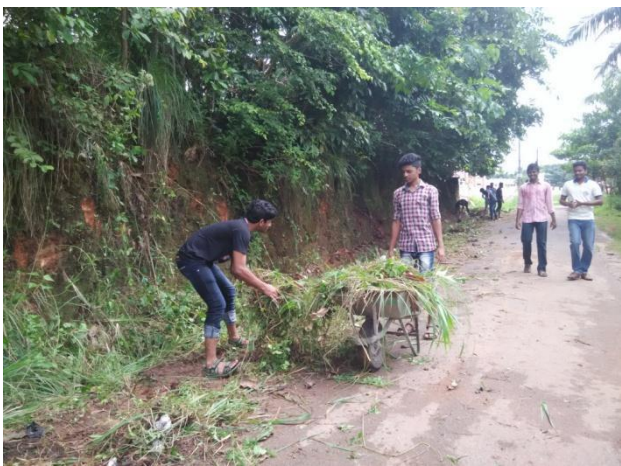

OBJECTIVE:

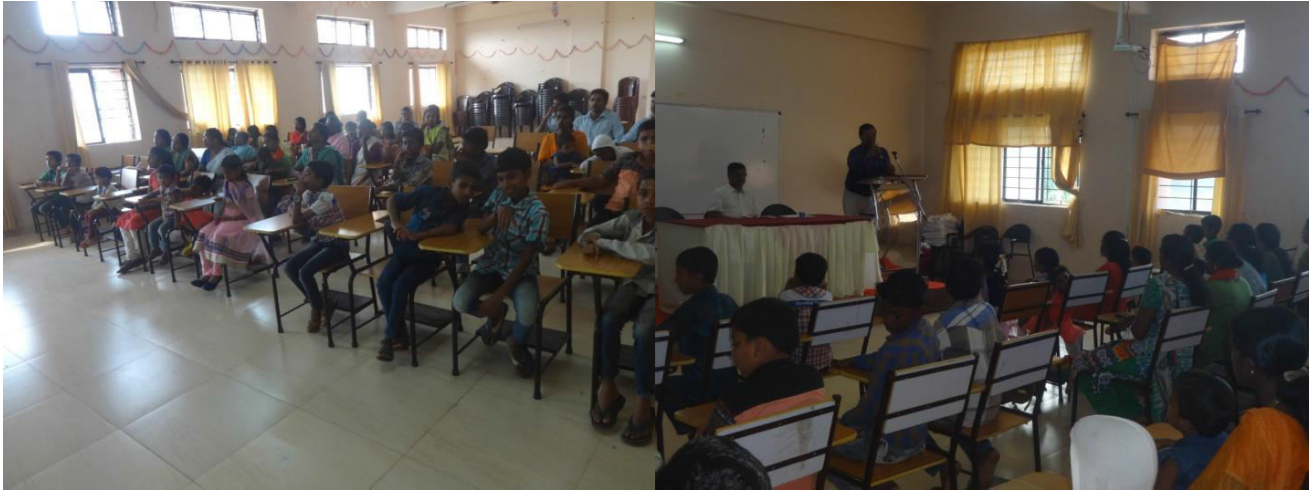
To distribute study materials to students in the locality as a part of helping the weaker section of the community.
