### **❖** AAC DEVICE - NISH

The AAC Device developed by the **Department of Electronics and Communication Engineering** for Entry level AAC Device Development Challenge organised by CATI-NISH and APJ AKTU is selected as the **FINALIST** (top 3 selected from the last level of top 5). **Hon. Minister for Higher** Education & Social Justice - Dr. R. Bindu inaugurated the function at NISH at 10 AM, on 25/07/2022 and awarded the certificate.

A team was formulated under the guidance of **Dr. Neethu Raj R( HoD ECE)**, with **Ms. Sreejitha S.G(Asst.Prof-ECE)** as Point of Contact, **Mr. Dawn Sivan(Asst.Prof-ECE)** and **Ms. Aswathi V Nair(Asst.Prof-ECE)** as Faculty members, **Mr. Briju V.G(TI-ECE)**, **Mr. Chandramohan B(TI-ECE)**, and **Ms. Anitha Kumari S.B(TI-ECE)** as Technical support. The endeavor is part of the APJ Abdul Kalam Technological University's (KTU) efforts to develop "**Made in Kerala**" indigenous AAC devices in collaboration with National Institute of Speech and Hearing (NISH). Seven Colleges were selected for submitting the developed AAC device and from which five colleges were selected as top five on January 2022. After testing the devices at the end user for months, three colleges were selected as finalists in July 2022 and VAST TC became one among the finalists.

Persons for whom natural speech or writing is insufficient to meet their communication needs require support or replacement of the conventional methods. Such persons can benefit from an Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) system. AAC intervention not only helps them in communicating better and doing their daily activities but also to attain independent living and thus a better quality of life. Beginners in AAC may start with low-technology devices which provide quick and easy help for meeting communication needs. When they attain basic proficiency in AAC, they may shift to high-technology devices that offer great sophistication in available vocabulary, speed of communication, and flexibility of access.

#### The device has the following features,

- 1. Able to record a message and then play back by activating a switch at the top surface.
- 2. With at least 2-minutes of record time in each level and three recording levels.
- 3. Loud, clear speaker output during playback and freedom from ambient noise while recording.
- 4. Water-proof, suitable for rugged use by children.
