

♦ PROGRAM OBJECTIVES


- Give students the confidence to prepare for recruitment drive.

Mr.Rajesh G.R.(**Asso.Prof- ECE**) was the Training Provider as he has fair experience in taking programming classes as part of curriculum and other workshops. 23 students of S7 ECE attended in the session. The session for S7 students started at 4 PM. **Ms. Sreejitha S.G**.(Asst.Prof-ECE) welcomed the resource person and students to the session. The session started with introducing the available jobs in computer industry in which most of them were not familiar to the students. The detailed description of each job and the requirements of job role were clearly mentioned during the session. Some of them were 3D animation or graphic design, Customer service, Database, Electronics engineer, Network or System Administrator, Security expert, Webmaster or Web designer. The key skills which programmer should learn and Top 8 Programming Languages which will improve the chance of employability were discussed. Some of the Languages are Python, Java, Ruby, MATLAB, SQL.

- Choose the right path for employability in future.



♦ WEBINAR ON MICROSERVICES ORGANISED BY DEPT. OF ECE

The Department of ECE conducted a webinar on "Microservices" for the S7 ECE students on 13th December,2020. Microservices Architecture is introducing the concept of developing functionality as a number of small self-contained services. This intends to clarify the implications of adopting this approach, appropriate usage, and how micro services can change an organization's approach to integration and delivering functionality through the digital channel. Ms. Sreejitha S G (Asst. Prof- ECE) coordinated the program under the guidance of Head of the Department, Dr.Neethu Raj R. The session started with an introduction by Ms. Anjana N (Asst. Prof- ECE). There were 24 students from S7 ECE as participants. Mr. Anand S.M. Senior System Engineer, Infosys Limited, Trivandrum delivered the lecture. The resource person is an Engineering graduate in Electronics and Communication Engineering. He joined as System Engineer. The course content delivered in the webinar is as follows: Comparison between Monolithic Architecture and Microservice Architecture was discussed in this session. The Speaker of the Session Mr. Anand S.M. presented the keynote address on "Microservices".





He discussed the basic concepts used in the technology relating with best suitable real life examples which are essential for the understanding of technology. He projected a clear understanding of the importance of Microservices and challenges in the Monolithic Architecture. He inspired the audience by lively interacting on topics such as new trends in android application development. He discussed about pros and cons of Monolithic Architecture and Microservice Architecture. He emphasized on Full Stack Developer career opportunities in India and global market and gaining practical mastery over programming through a handson project. He projected on comprehending the theoretical concepts and relating to the practical aspects of Microservices. Also the feedback about the session was collected from all the participants to improve the sessions that will be conducted in the mere future. The program was arranged with the motive of sharing the knowledge and practical experience of Mr. Anand S.M.The webinar was helpful and it satisfied the participants.

✤ "GROUP TUTOR SYSTEM AND COUNSELLING" ORGANIZED BY VIDYA STUDENT SUPPORT CELL, VAST TC

Vidya Student Support Cell (VSSC) is a forum, initiated by the management, to provide additional academic as well as emotional support to needy students. To equip the faculty to effectively counsel students, this academic year VSSC conducted a Faculty development programme on "Group Tutor System and Counselling" for those who have less than three-year experience and not attended this session by VSSC yet. Twenty-one faculties were identified and the session was conducted at Mechanical Seminar Hall, VAST TC on **15th December**, **2020** from **11AM to 12PM**.

♦ PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

- To introduce VSSC to newly joined faculty.
- To familiar the functioning of VSSC.
- To explain Group Tutor system.
- Explain the detailed guidelines to Group Tutors.



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• Discuss Counselling process and purpose.

• Importance of VSSC during this pandemic.

♦ RESOURCE PERSON and PARTICIPANTS

Ms. Sreejitha S.G.(Asst.Prof-ECE), Chief Coordinator VSSC, VAST TC handled the session. Nineteen faculty members from various departments attended the session.

\diamond SESSION DETAILS.

- The session for newly joined faculty started at 11 AM on 15th December 2020 at Seminar hall. The chief coordinator, VSSC handled the session in which nineteen faculties attended. It started with general introduction about VSSC and its activities. Then introduced Group tutor system whereby a group of twenty-two students are put under the patronage of a faculty member designated as the 'group tutor'.
- > After which the functioning of VSSC was described with the help of a flow chart.
- Covered Primary responsibilities of Group Tutor, Report maintaining, submission of monthly report to Department coordinator, attention to students who has academic deviation.
- Intention and frequency of PTA meeting were discussed. General Functions of VSSC also explained.
- Introduced different department coordinators to whom each group tutor must submit the monthly report.

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- ✤ Guidelines to Group Tutor was explained
 - Group Tutors should closely monitor the regularity & performance of every student under him/her.
 - Group Tutors should keep a file to record the continuous evaluation (academic as well as personal details) for each student under him/her.
 - Group Tutors to meet every student personally once in two weeks and to update his\her status regularly.
 - Group Tutors to meet every student after the publication of result (series test or university result) and counselling report to be made accordingly.
 - Case of deviation of academic performance/ Shortages of attendance should be given special attention and to be brought to the notice of parents and VSSC coordinator.
 - After series test those who require academic support are to be listed and action to be taken for remedial classes.
 - After first & second series PTA meetings to be conducted for each class. Appreciation for toppers in series examinations to be done during PTA meeting.
 - Students with three or more subject's failures should be given special counselling classes by the tutor or by the Counsellor as per the requirement.
 - Group Tutors can meet the counsellor personally if they require any assistance while interacting with the students.
 - Group Tutors of respective Classes should meet monthly.
 - Monthly counseling report (soft copy) by Group Tutors to be submitted to Dept. VSSC coordinator as well as to the concerned HoDs.
 - The Dept. Coordinators should submit the report to VSSC Chief Coordinator.
 - The VSSC Chief coordinator to submit the final report to the Principal.

♦ PROGRAM OUTCOMES

- > The functioning of VSSC and Group Tutor system was made clear.
- Faculty understood the role of group tutor in mentoring students under his/her tutorship.



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- > Understood the importance of record keeping and meeting report submission.
- Understood activities of VSSC during and after Series Test, University examination and guidelines to group tutor.
- Faculty understood the importance of counseling students and parents to identify the issues due to online classes and how to support them.

Faculty found this session to be useful as many of them are freshers. Being a tutor in this online world, this session gave them a support and guidance to handle students. Some of them had doubts regarding "How and when to meet students", "How to record meeting details", "Records and confidentiality" and these were cleared during the session. - 2. Directions




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3. The topics are selected as per the suggestions from students. Soft copy of the relevant

✤ CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION






