REPORT ON Dr.Sudheer S V visit regarding NAAC

OBJECTIVE

To understand the accreditation process of National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC).

OVERVIEW

Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) of Vidya Academy of Science and Technology Technical Campus, VAST TC, organized a programme regarding NAAC for teaching and non-teaching staffs of VAST TC on **17th March 2021** from 9.30 am to 2.30 pm at seminar hall SB 615 . The **resource person** was **Dr. S.V.Sudheer**, Pro Vice-Chancellor, Sree Narayana Guru Open University. Principal **Dr.T Mathavaraj Ravikumar** was the Programme Advisor and **Mr.Aswin M Menon**(Assistant Professor, Mechanical Engineering Department, VAST TC) was the Programme Coordinator.

PARTICIANTS

Total 30 teaching staffs and 22 non-teaching staffs attended the programme.

PROGRAMME DETAILS

The programme started with a welcome speech by Ms.Anjana N (Assistant Professor, Electronics and Communication Engineering Department,VAST TC). The programme was structured in two sessions, followed by a doubt clearance session.

Session 1

Session started at 9.45 am. Dr.V.Sudheer explained NAAC process including the quantitative (70%) and qualitative (30%) divisions, uploading of documents related to quantitative matrices and peer team visit. The session ended at 11.00 am

Important points shared during session 1 are following:

- From quantitative matrices, a score of 30% is very essential to get eligibility for peer team visit. Keep Self Study Report (SSR) ready prior to uploading documents.
- College functioning should be gone as usual on peer team visit days (two days).
- First 45 minutes of the first day of peer team visit is an interaction with principal. After this, there may be an interaction with IQAC coordinator. Next activity is the departmental visit. During this time, they come to know the facilities of departments. Departmental visit will be followed by an interaction with the representative group of students (30 minutes) and interaction with alumni and parents (30 minutes). At the end of the day, there should be a cultural programme by college students for 45 minutes. Report preparation by peer team and exit meeting will be held during second day.

Session 2

Session 2 started at 11.15 am. In this session, the seven criteria and the important files to be kept at department during Data Validation and Verification (DVV) time were explained. The session ended at 2.15 pm.

PROGRAMME OUTCOME

- Learned basic and important details related to NAAC.
- The program helped to gain an understanding of the activities during the two-day peer team visit.
