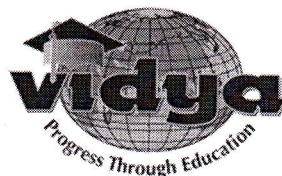

Objectives

The SC/ST Committee is constituted to ensure a safe, inclusive, and equitable environment for students and employees belonging to the Scheduled Castes (SC) and Scheduled Tribes (ST). The Committee safeguards their rights, promotes equal opportunities, facilitates access to welfare schemes, and addresses issues related to discrimination, thereby fostering social justice and inclusiveness within the institution.

Roles and Responsibilities

1. Promote an inclusive, respectful, and discrimination-free campus environment by ensuring equal opportunities for SC/ST students and staff in academic, administrative, and campus activities.
2. Create awareness about constitutional provisions, reservation policies, scholarships, government welfare schemes, and institutional support available for SC/ST students and employees.
3. Receive and address grievances related to discrimination, harassment, or denial of rights, and recommend appropriate action in accordance with institutional policies and statutory guidelines.
4. Facilitate the implementation of government welfare schemes, scholarships, financial assistance, mentoring, counselling, and academic support programmes for eligible students.
5. Coordinate with departments and other institutional committees to monitor the effective implementation of policies and initiatives related to the welfare of SC/ST students and staff.
6. Maintain records of committee activities, grievances, and action taken, submit periodic reports to the Principal, and ensure compliance with the guidelines of UGC, AICTE, KTU, NBA, NAAC, and other applicable statutory authorities.
