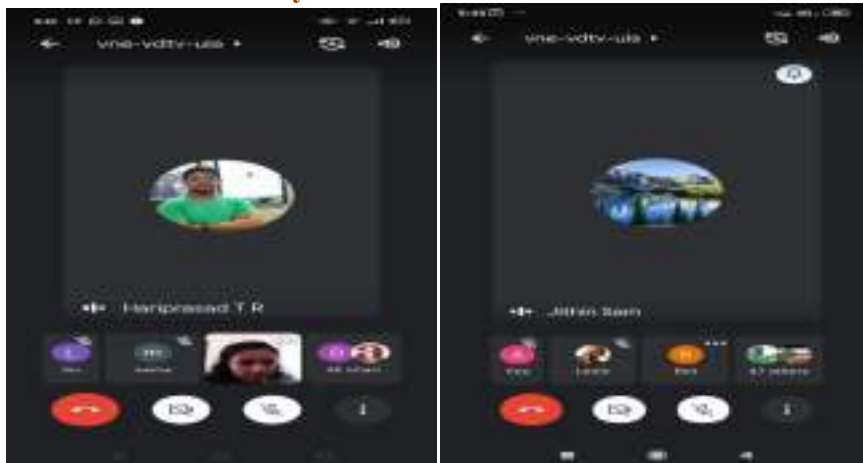
❖ **CIVIL ENGINEERING**

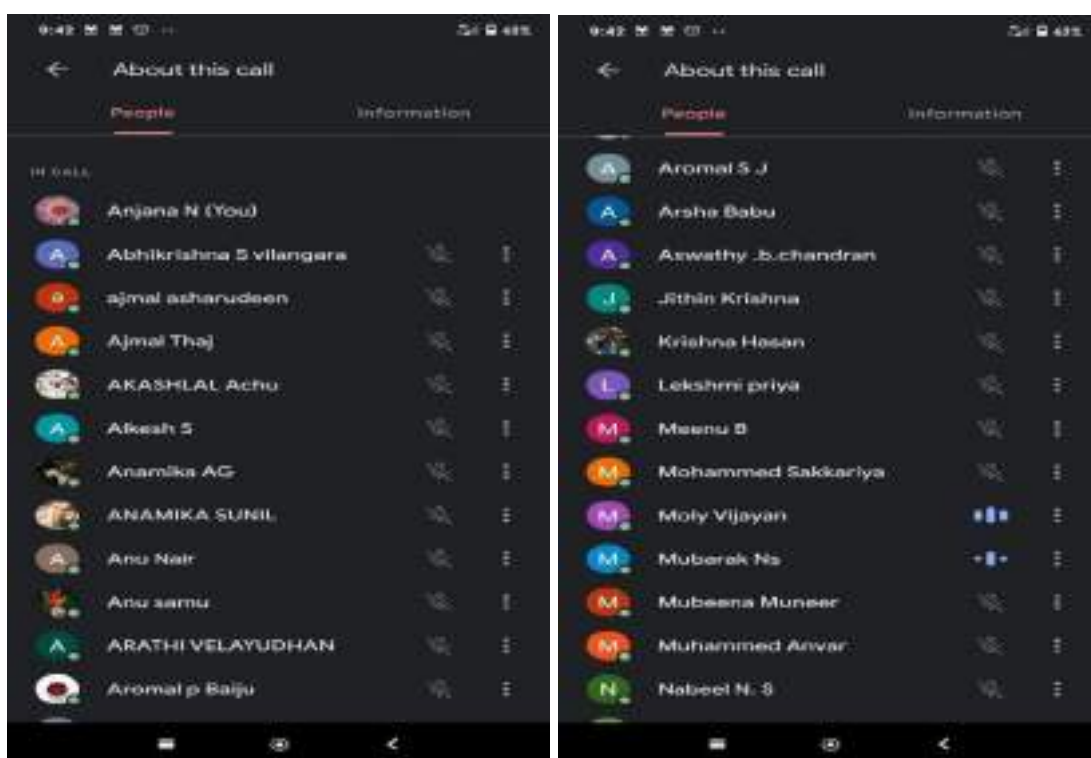
- Explained about the timings of Induction Programme and the relevance of the topic of various sessions

❖ ELECTRICAL AND ELECTRONICS ENGINEERING

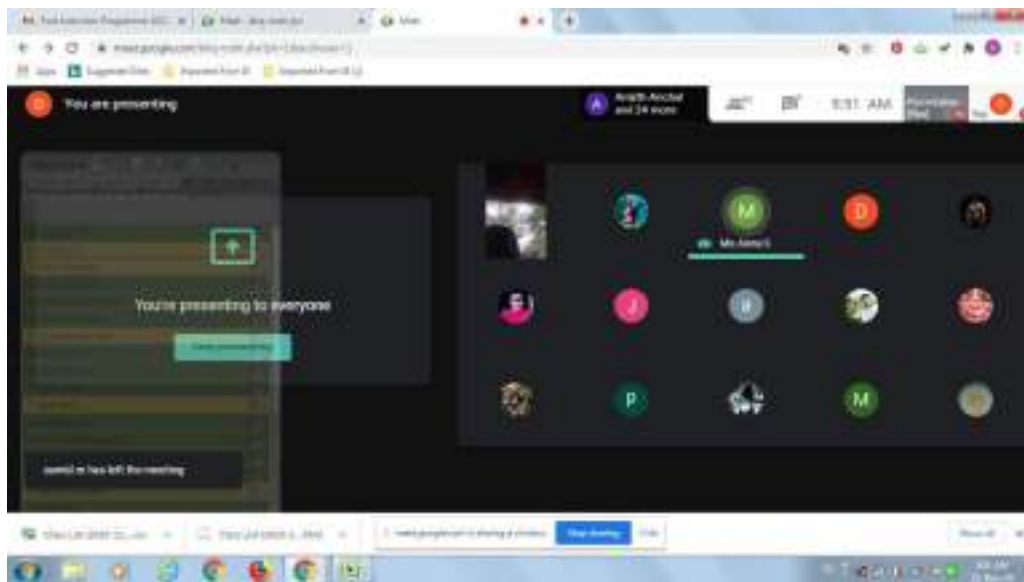
The Induction Program for 2020-24 batch started with a session named “**Introduction to Induction Program.**” The session started by 9.30 am in Google meet. Forty students

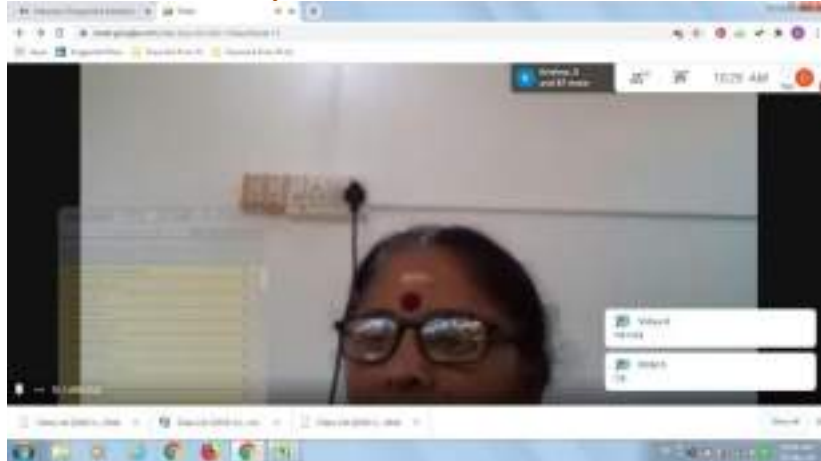

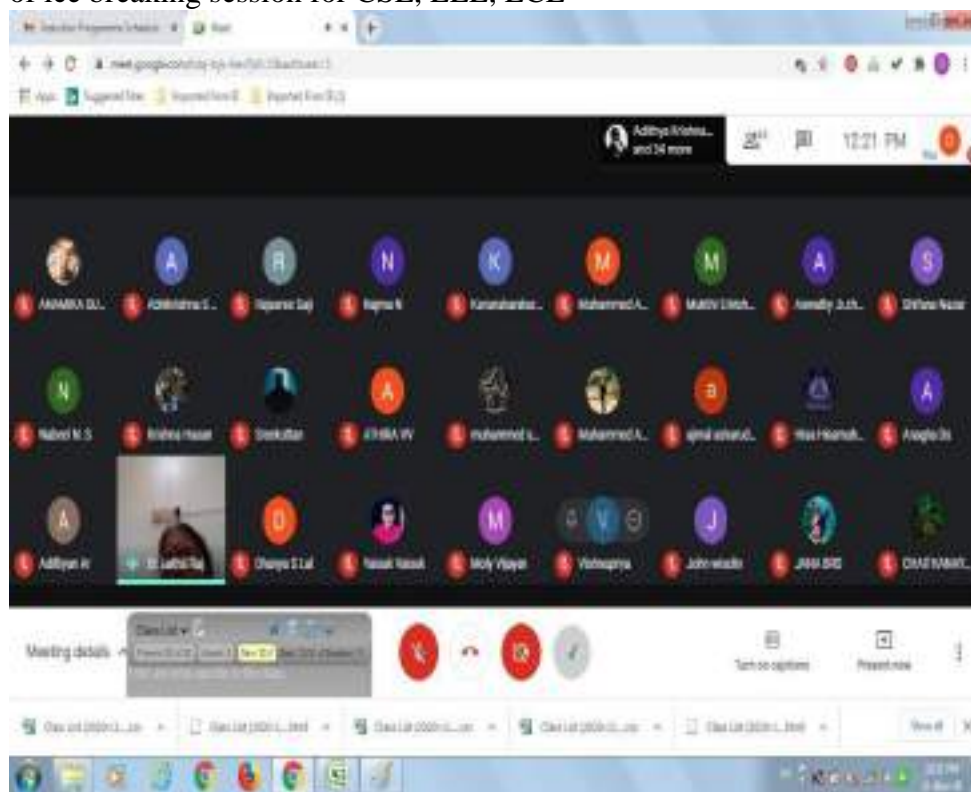




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Pictures of ice breaking session for CSE, EEE, ECE

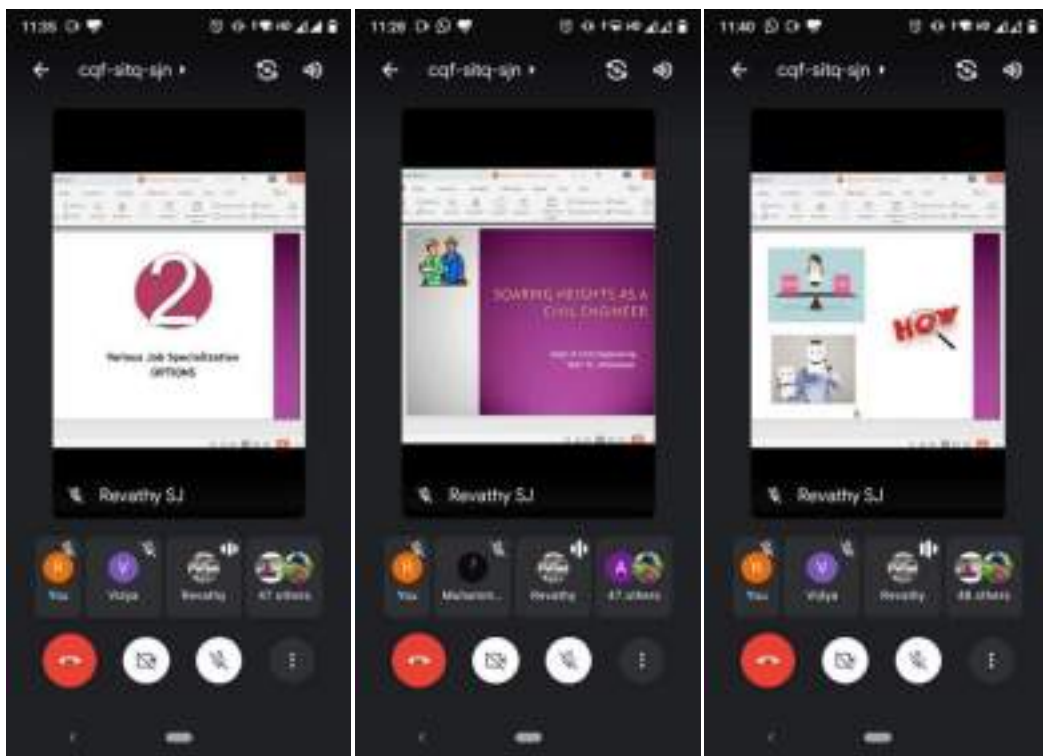

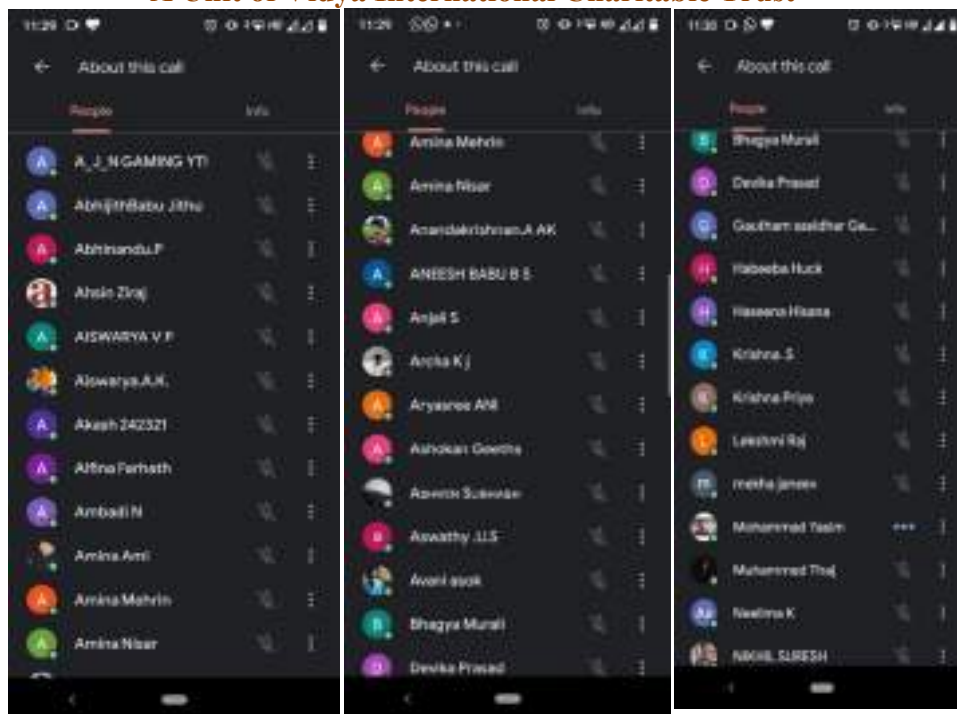

- Need of degree in Computer Science and Engineering after plus two.



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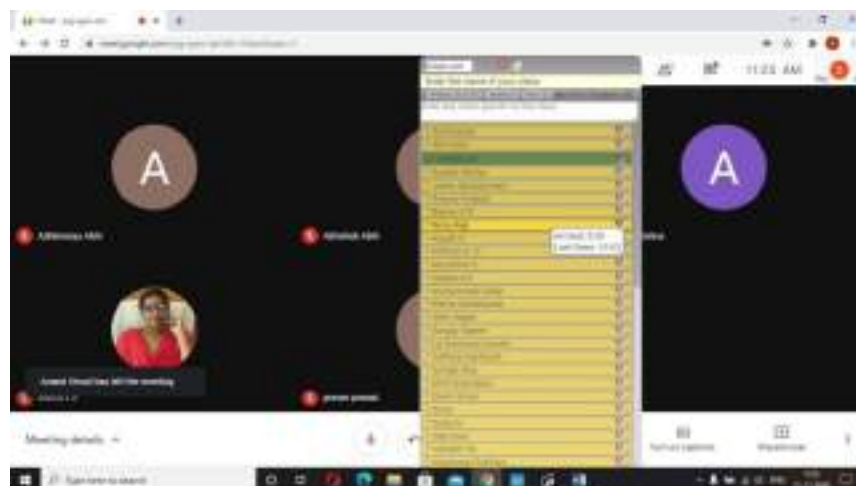
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- Career opportunities after degree in CSE

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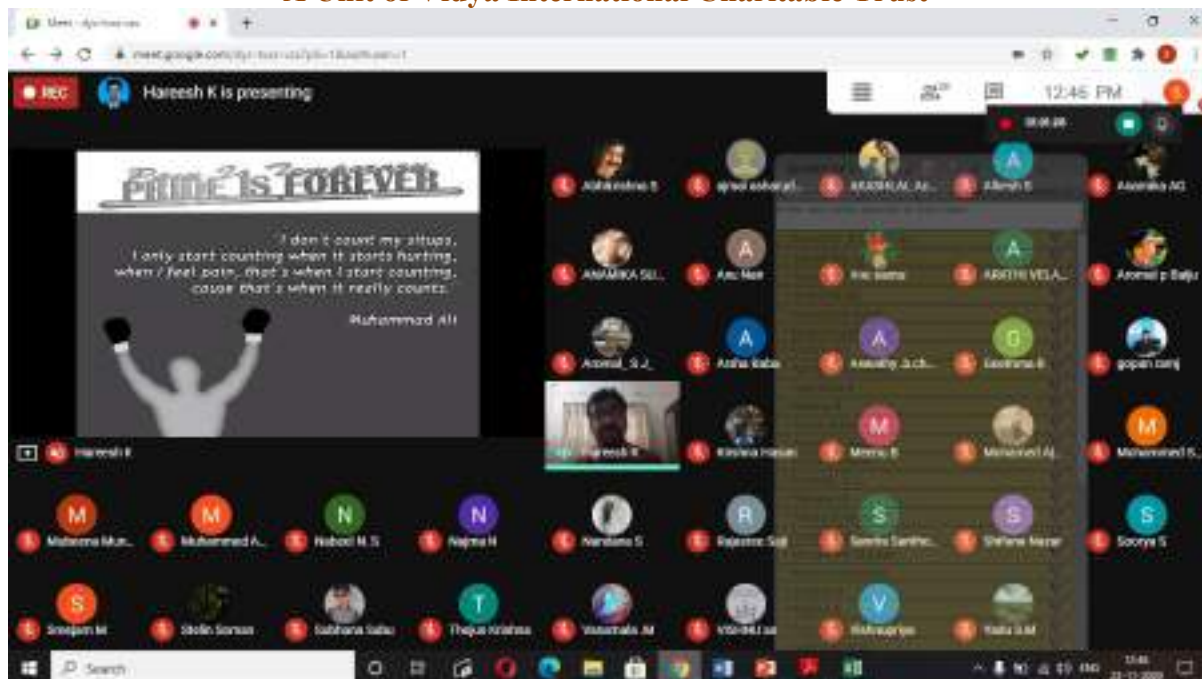

- He also briefly mentioned the various offences acts relating drug abuse.

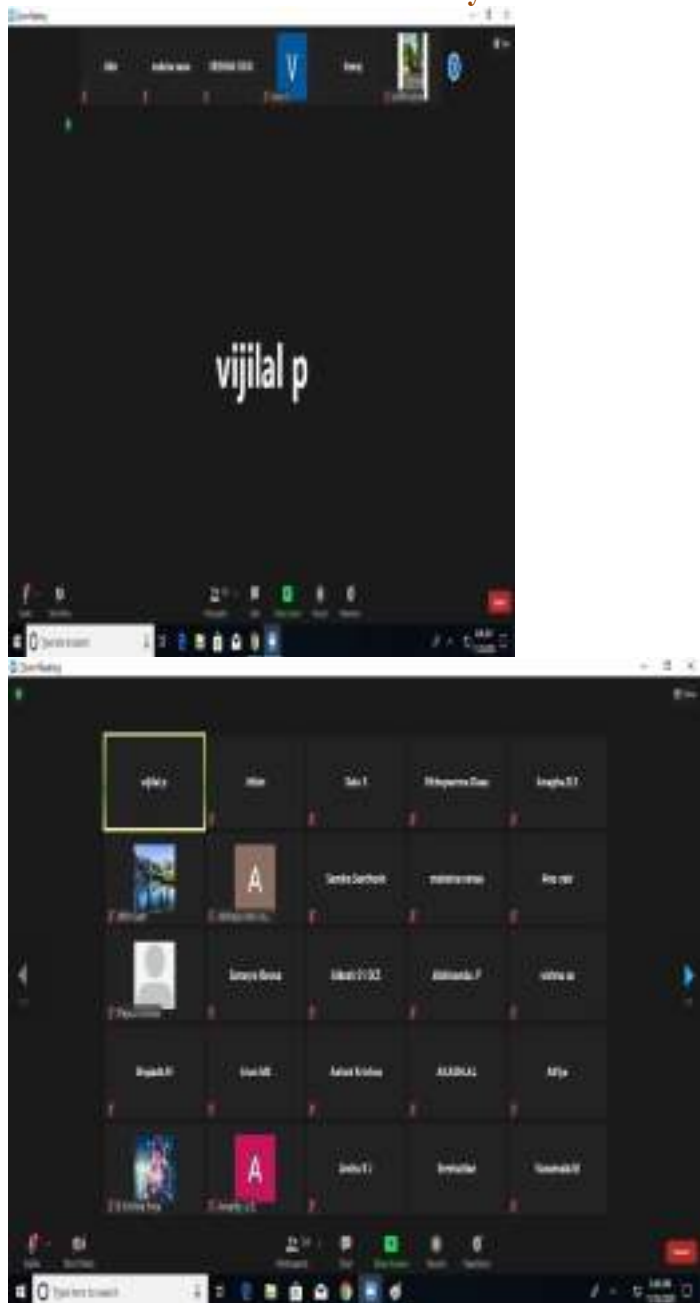

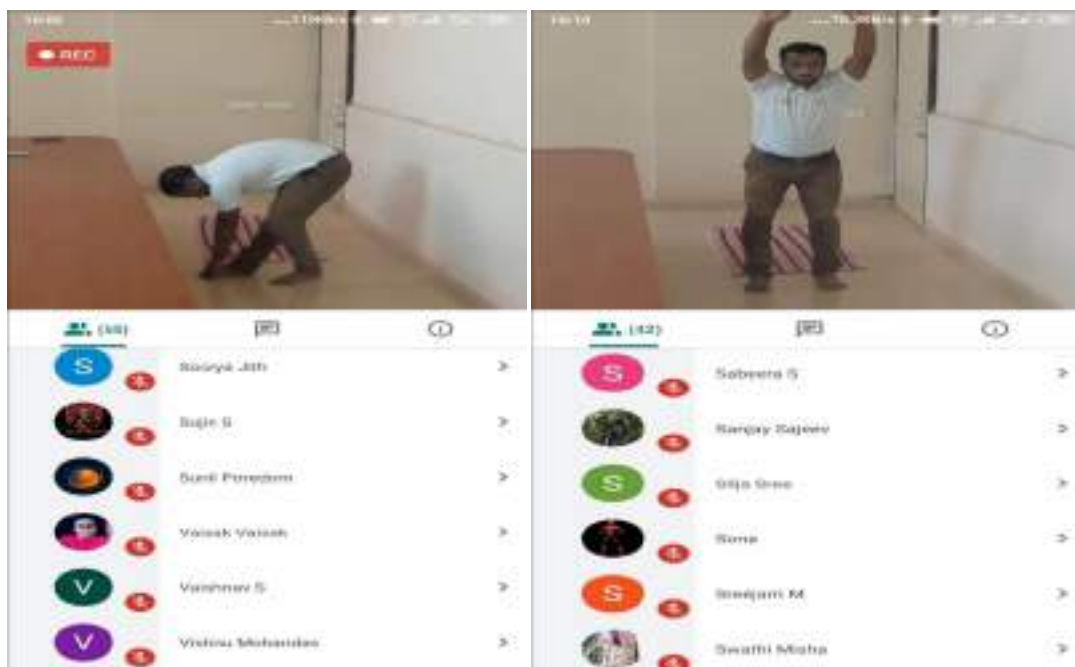

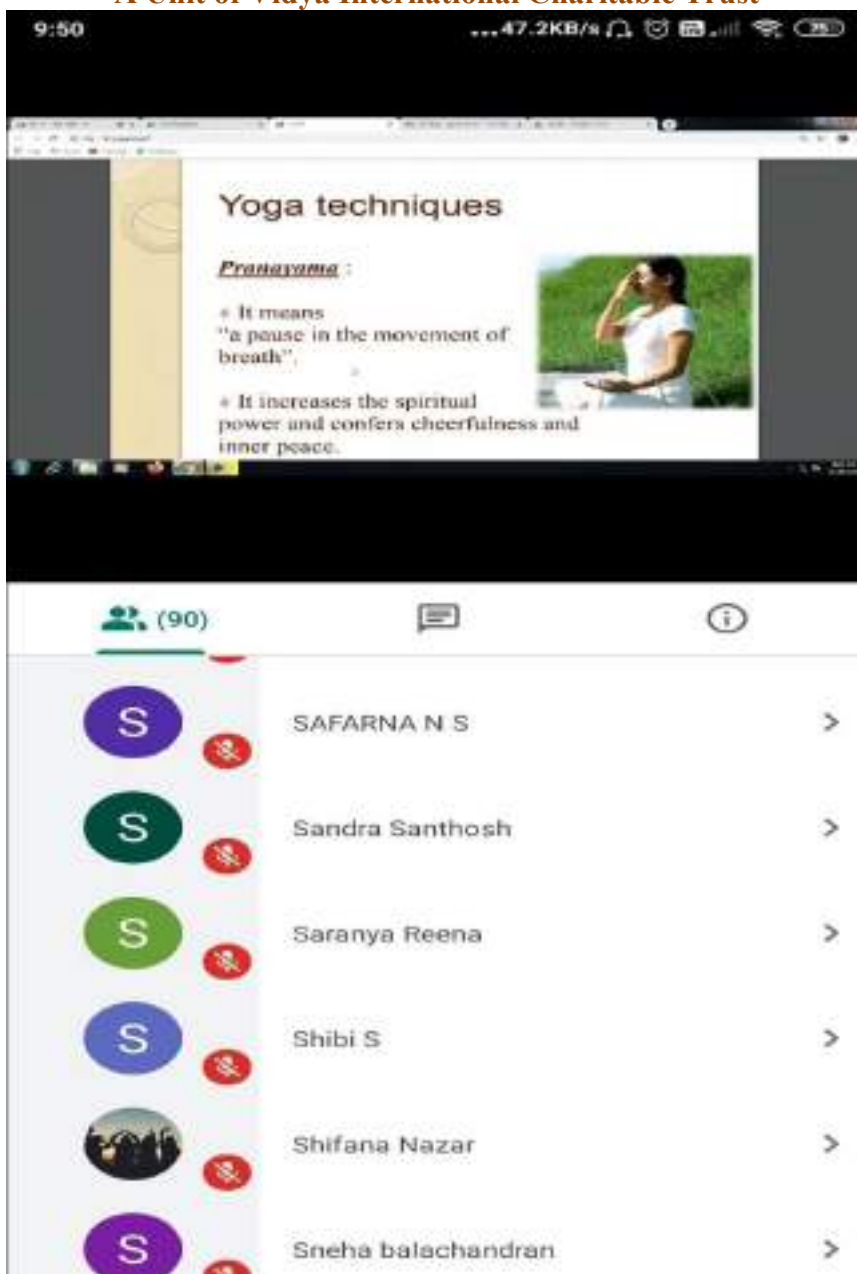




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❖ FUN MATHS

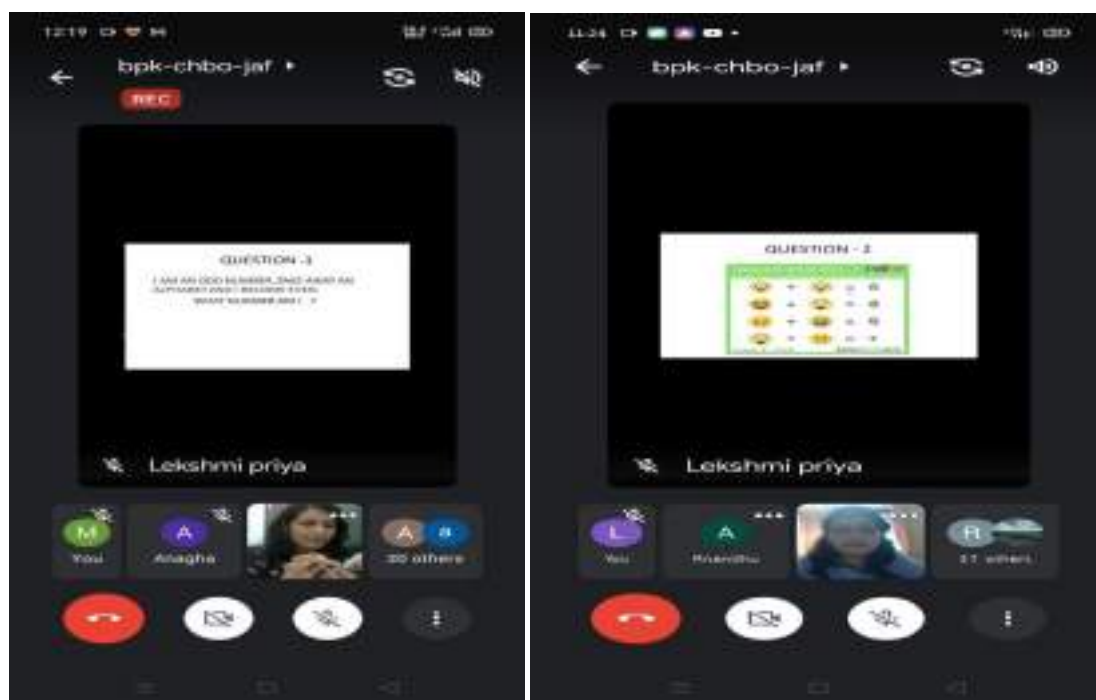

- ✧ Make masks and distribute them through social welfare organisations nearby

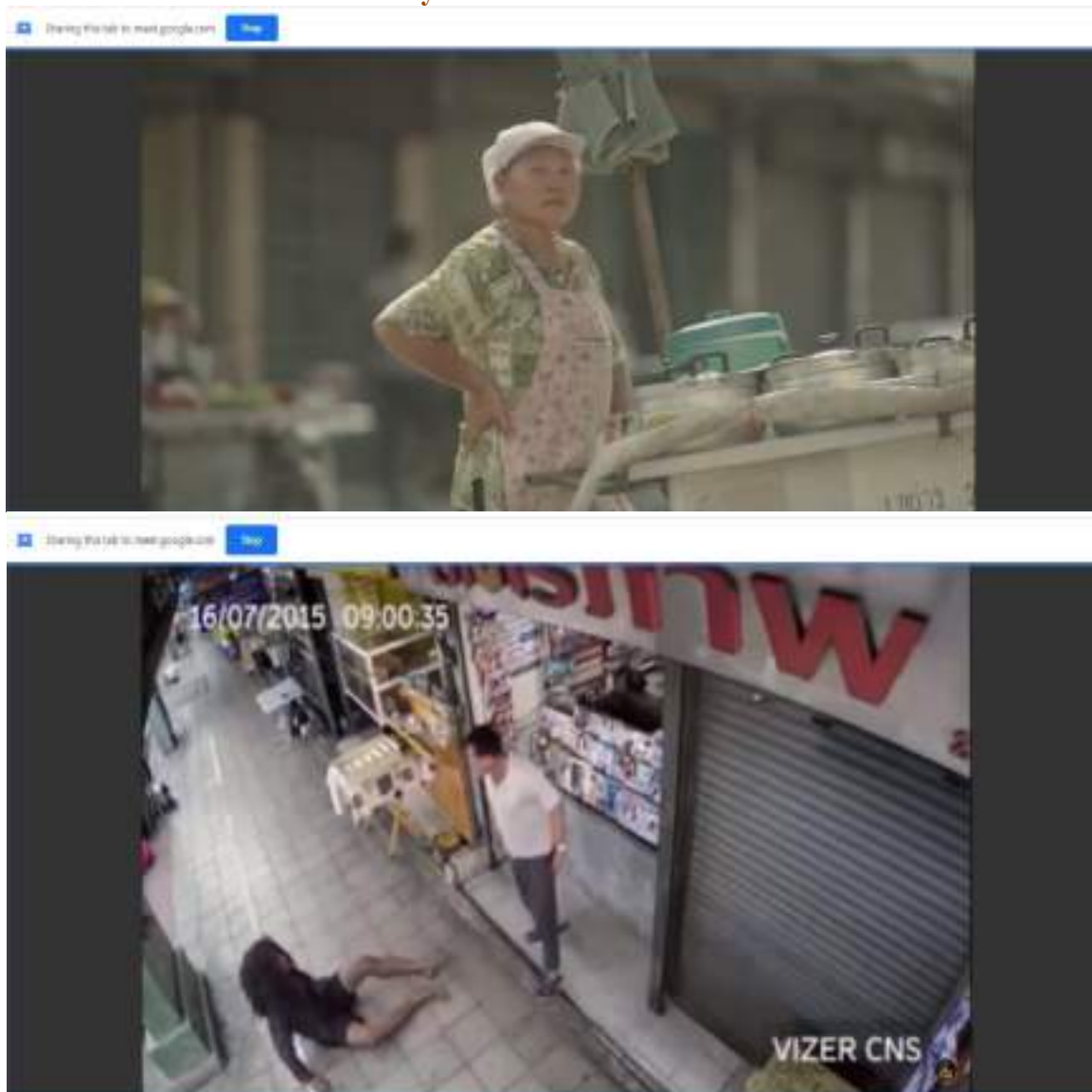
The session which was attended by 35 students of the department, concluded at 10: 30 a.m.

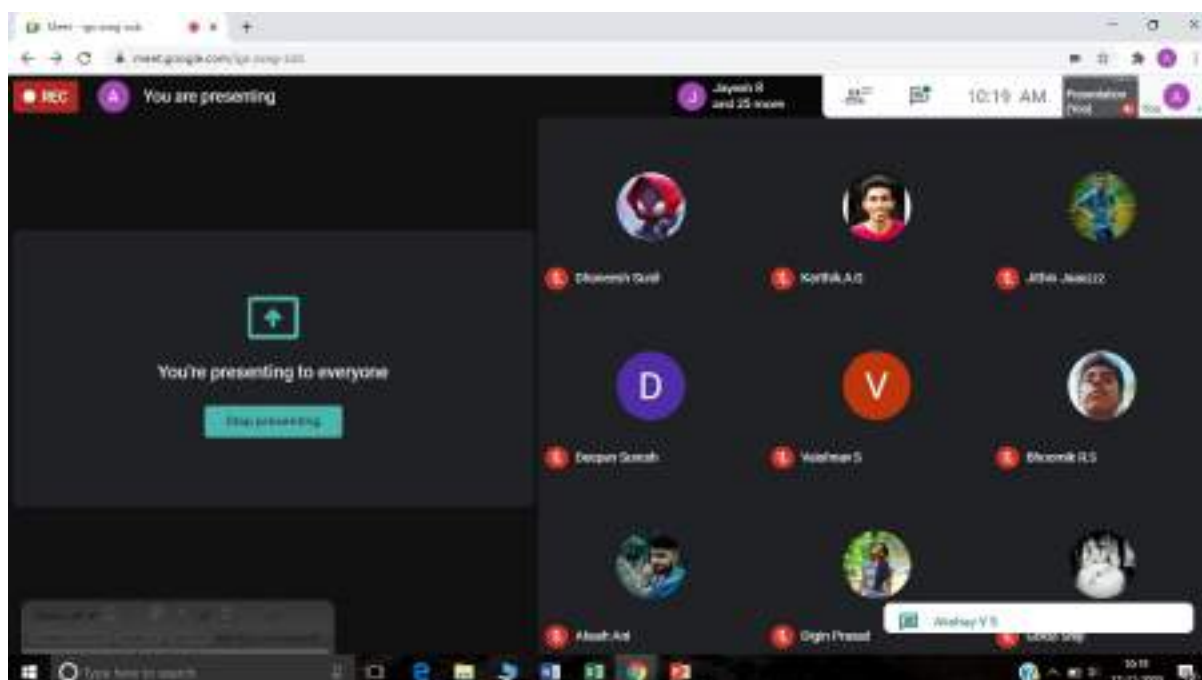
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❖ **REPORT ON POSTRE/MODEL/CRAFT MAKING SESSION**

- Explained how the Engineers enhance human welfare using their skill and knowledge.

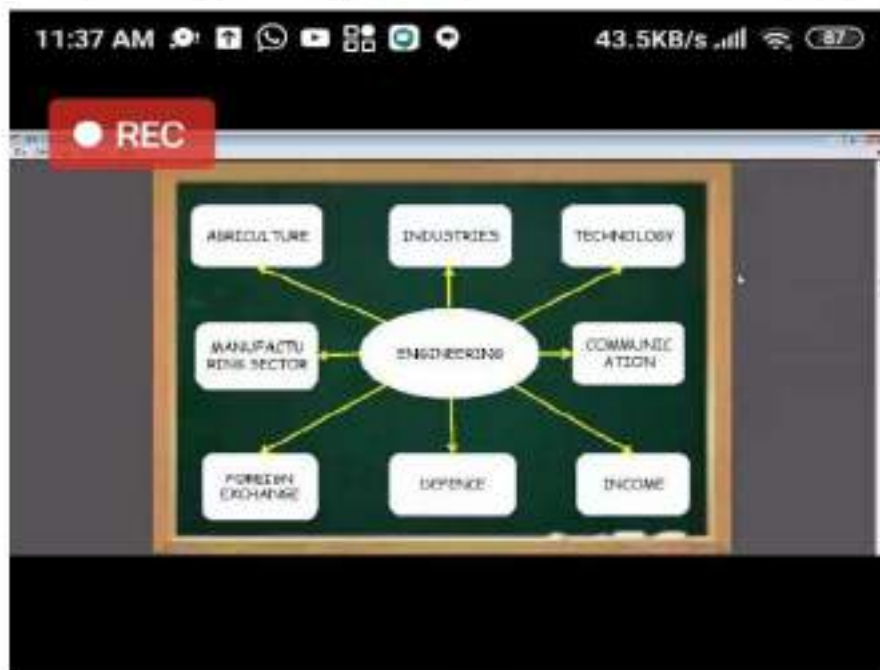
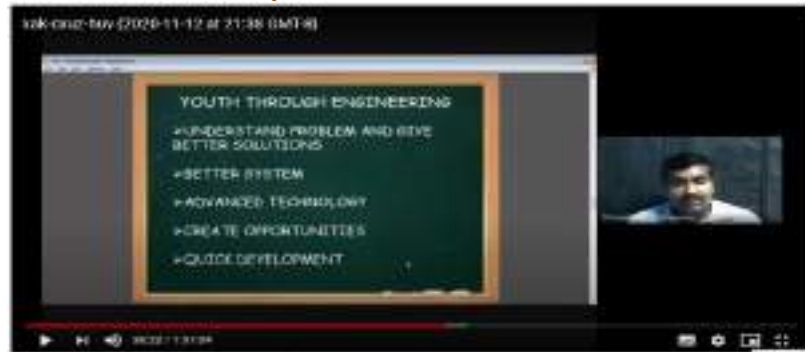

All students were given participation certificate and activity points were also given for the same

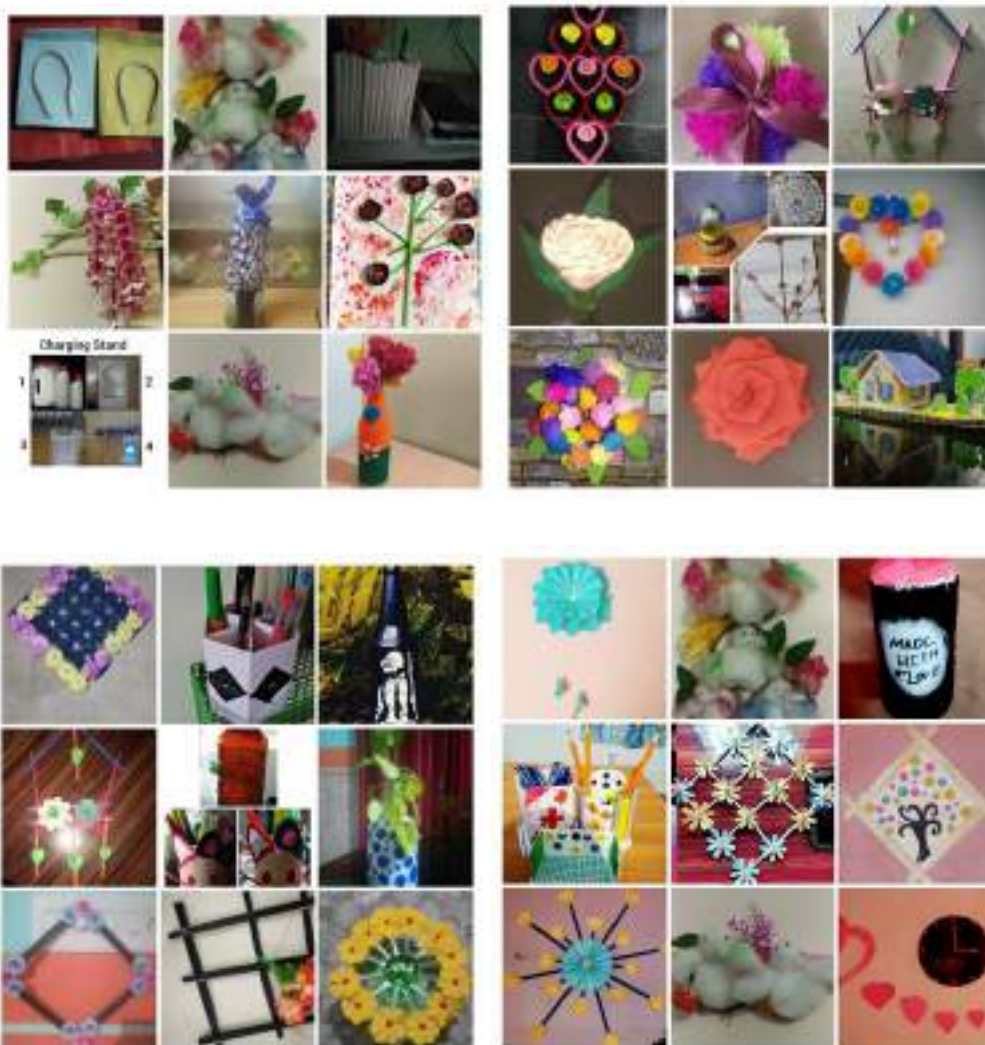

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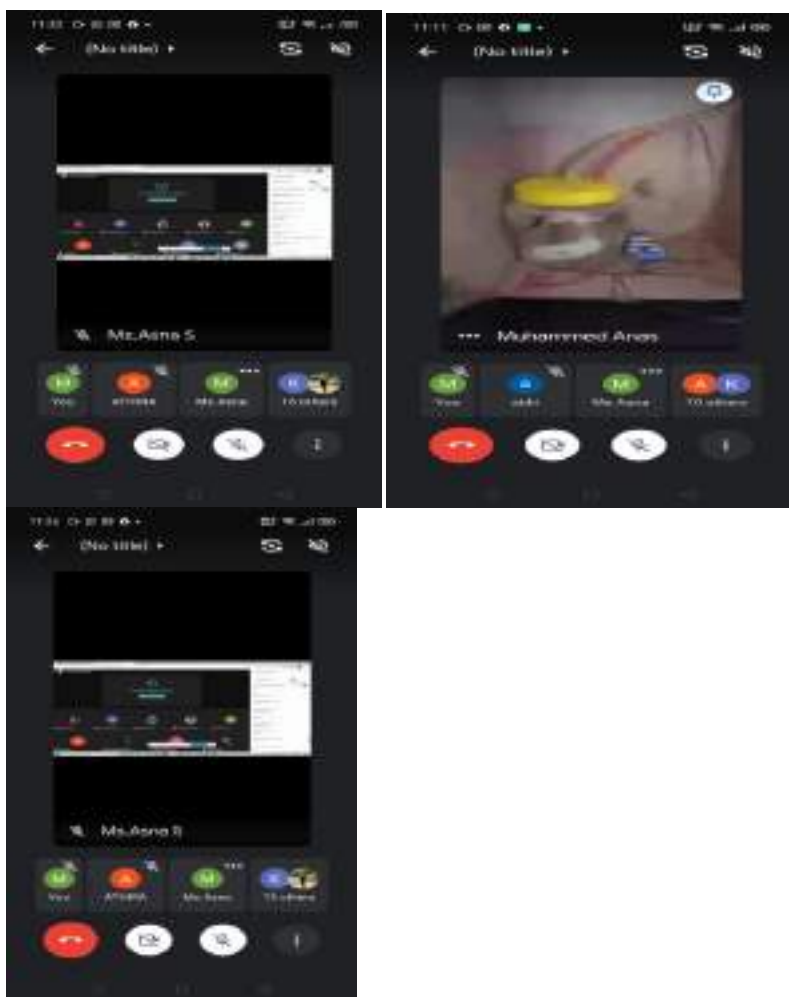
