
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❖ WEBINAR ON "ELECTRIC AND HYBRID VEHICLE"



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
❖ ONLINE SHORT TERM COURSE ON "CNC MACHINING AND PART PROGRAMMING"








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*** POSTER DESIGNING COMPETITION**

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* ONLINE EXPERT TALK ON PERSONAL BRANDING AND NETWORKING




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❖ 20 RUPEES CHALLENGE ORGANIZED BY NSS UNIT
